
HOW DOES eBONDS™ WORK?



THE PROCESS

Once a cosigner completes the bond application with a local bondsman, the eBONDS process begins. It starts with a Bail Bond Agent logging into the eBONDS portal — which is integrated with the jail's JMS system — to create a bond. Once submitted, a Jailer reviews and certifies the bond for book out. The inmate signs the bond electronically and can then be released. Copies of the secure, signed bond documents are immediately available for the inmate's jail record and the Bail Bond Agent.
