Unlike outdated paper workflows or loosely managed digital submissions, eBONDS delivers a fully electronic process that eliminates manual errors, accelerates turnaround times, and ensures every transaction is properly documented and accessible in real time. With seamless integration into jail management systems and surety carrier networks, eBONDS enables staff to complete the entire bail bond process quickly, accurately, and securely, **all at no cost to the jail**.

THE PROCESS

- 1** The eBONDS dashboard provides a simple, easy-to-use interface where bail bonds can be entered, updated, and processed. The system guides the user through the process with clear, step-by-step instructions. This begins when a Bail Bond Agent logs into the eBONDS portal, which is integrated into the jail's JMS, to create and submit a bond application, without ever having to visit the jail.
- 2** Once submitted, a jailer reviews and certifies the bond application and corresponding electronic power to prepare the inmate for book out. Gone are the days of hand-delivered documents or waiting for signatures.
- 3** The inmate signs the bond electronically and can then be released. Copies of the secure, signed bond documents as well as the verified electronic powers are immediately available for the inmate's jail record and for the bond agent.
- 4** Throughout the process, deputies, jail staff, and bail agents receive real-time updates on the status of the bond. This ensures that everyone involved is on the same page and that detainees are processed without unnecessary delays or calls to the jail.
- 5** eBONDS keeps detailed records of every transaction, making it easy to generate reports, track bond statuses, and ensure compliance with audit requirements. Records are stored in the Azure government cloud and have no expiration date of when they can be accessed.



GETTING STARTED WITH eBONDS

Implementing eBONDS is quick and straightforward. Our team provides full onboarding support, from training jail staff and bail bond agents to assisting with system integration. We work closely with customers to ensure that eBONDS is fully customized to meet their needs and seamlessly integrates with their existing infrastructure.

How much does eBONDS cost?

The use license for eBONDS is provided to the jail at no cost. Some JMS vendors may charge a setup or integration cost. Minimal ongoing fees are paid by the bondsmen.

How does eBONDS handle the payment of bond fees?

All payments are collected electronically within eBONDS and then routed through the customer's payment gateway to the designated account. There are also financial reports available in eBONDS to assist with any reconciliation, accounting, or treasury reporting.

How reliable is the information in eBONDS?

Since eBONDS has a direct connection to the jail's data management system, the information is constantly being synced. Therefore, when information is updated on the jail side, it is automatically updated in eBONDS as well.

Who can we call if we have an issue or need training?

eBONDS has Customer Support available 24/7 for critical issues and training is provided onsite for jail staff and bondsmen before going live with eBONDS. Training materials are also provided for any future training needs.

WHAT IT IS

eBONDS is owned by a 35-year independent and private public safety software company located in Tyler, Texas.

eBONDS is implemented based on local decisions by local officials, bondsmen, and jail administration.

eBONDS is not affiliated with any insurance company, government entity, or other software solution (such as AIA or Tyler Technologies).

eBONDS is not accessed on a state or national level. Only locally approved bondsmen have access.

eBONDS is not a replacement for any local bondsmen or other software (such as Simply Bail or Captira).

eBONDS is not dependent on the most easily compromised forms or communication (such as email, fax, or paper).
